



Resilient Ratties Activities

Egg Carton Resilient Ratties!

Myself and my daughter Ellie saw pictures of this craft idea on social media and decided to make our own Resilient Ratties! Here's how we did it.

Materials Required:



- Egg Carton (you will get two 'rats' out of a 6 egg carton)
- Scissors
- Knife
- Sticky tape
- Card
- Black marker & pen
- Red, pink & orange pens
- Yellow paint
- Glue
- Paint brush
- String



STEP 1

Using the knife or scissors cut out the pillars in middle of the cartons – Ask an adult to help with this part.



STEP 2

Using the knife or scissors cut out holes in the carton (for the cheese holes!) – Ask an adult to help with this part.



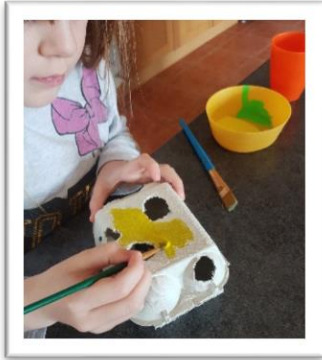
STEP 3

Draw and colour in some ears on the card and cut them out with the scissors.





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STEP 4

Paint the egg box yellow (unless you have a yellow egg box!!) and put it to the side to dry.



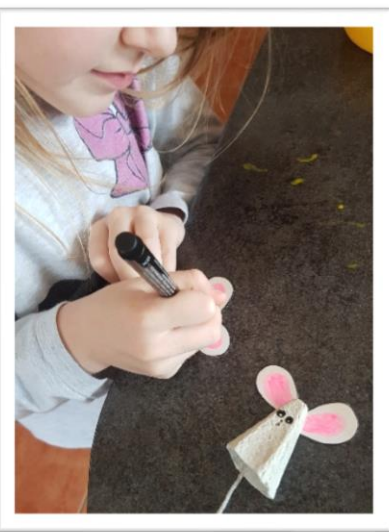
STEP 5

Using the glue, stick the ears on to the back of the egg box pillars. Make sure the coloured parts are facing forward!



STEP 6

Cut some tails from the ball of string and stick to the inside of the egg box pillars with sticky tape.



STEP 7

Use a black pen to draw some ratty faces!





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STEP 8

The ratties wouldn't be Resilient Ratties without a STOPP sign and Fizz bottle! Draw into card and sticky taped onto cocktail sticks.
